



Grants Manager

The Grants Manager will report to the Chief Development and Education Officer and will work closely with development program staff. This is a full time, 40 hour position.

Major Responsibilities:

- Research, design, write, edit, and submit grant applications and reports
- Attend local donor meetings with development staff as needed
- Provide follow up materials to donors on timely basis
- Assist with annual report and other development communications as needed
- Prepare and submit reports and correspondence to funders

Successful candidates will demonstrate:

- Ability to work in a diverse team.
- Ability to work under pressure and adhere to deadlines
- Ability to plan, prioritize, manage, control and execute tasks on timely matters
- Strong interpersonal and verbal communication skills
- Have high levels of motivation, self-reliance, and independence

- Strong written and oral English proficiency
- Willingness to work non-traditional hours on occasion, such as nights and weekends
