As a Workforce Development Intern, you will learn how to navigate community-based collaborations with workforce partners, research effective strategies from across the globe, and contribute to the design and implementation of our workforce classes. This intern will directly work with students to practice soft skills, learning management systems and resume preparation. This position will report to the Occupational and Training Specialist and is primarily remote.

Commitment: Minimum of 15 hours per week; specific schedule to be negotiated with the supervisor.

- Strong research and writing skills.
- Ability to work independently in a fast paced environment.
- Ability to navigate language barriers.
